Raytheon signs LoI with Poland's TELDAT

US defence company Raytheon has signed a Letter of Intent (LoI) with Polish defence electronics firm TELDAT covering co-operation in Poland's air-defence programme and potential export markets, the company announced on 28 July.

Poland's Armaments Inspectorate invited Raytheon in July to participate in the formal procurement process for its WISLA medium-range air and missile defence system, part of the wider Shield of Poland air defence programme. Raytheon's Patriot will compete against the EUROSAM consortium (Thales and MBDA-France) offering SAMP/T.

According to Raytheon, the LoI will cover four categories of work: IP-based networking solutions, software and devices; militarized communications equipment; command and control software; and system integration, verification and validation testing.
